## Freudian Collage Activity

The purpose of this activity is:

- 1. to explore Freud's structural components of the mind.
- 2. to express these concepts with modern images and words.
- 3. to use images, as well as words to express Freud's ideas.

Your Collage will be assessed in three ways:

Images: [35 points]

- 1. The collage will contain at least 3 different images for each of Freud's concepts [Id, Ego, Super Ego]
- 2. The collage will be organized into 3 parts, according to each concept
- 3. The collage will be neat and well organized

Writing: [30 points]

- 1. You will write a short description [2 to 3 paragraphs] for each of the 3 sections
- 2. The writing will attempt to use the language and terms of a Freudian Psychologist
- 3. Your writing will be both descriptive and analytical. You will explain why you chose each image and how it connects to the concept of that particular section

Presentation: [15 points]

- 1. You will give a brief presentation of your Collage to the class
- 2. You will present, not read, your poster and how you connected the images to the ideas [You may use notes].

The teacher will provide some class time for this project.

On Tuesday [5/2]

you will have at least 30 minutes to choose and cut images and write a rough draft for the reasons that you chose them

On Thursday [5/8]

you will have at least 30 minutes to begin attaching them to teacher supplied 18 inch by 12-inch paper

Your Collage will be due to the teacher Wednesday, [5/10]

Your presentation will be due upon the return of your work

Presentations will begin on 5/10 and finish 5/12
