

Freudian Collage Activity

The purpose of this activity is:

1. to explore Freud's structural components of the mind.
2. to express these concepts with modern images and words.
3. to use images, as well as words to express Freud's ideas.

Your Collage will be assessed in three ways:

Images: [35 points]

1. The collage will contain at least 3 different images for each of Freud's concepts [Id, Ego, Super Ego]
2. The collage will be organized into 3 parts, according to each concept
3. The collage will be neat and well organized

Writing: [30 points]

1. You will write a short description [2 to 3 paragraphs] for each of the 3 sections
2. The writing will attempt to use the language and terms of a Freudian Psychologist
3. Your writing will be both descriptive and analytical. You will explain why you chose each image and how it connects to the concept of that particular section

Presentation: [15 points]

1. You will give a brief presentation of your Collage to the class
2. You will present, not read, your poster and how you connected the images to the ideas
[You may use notes].

The teacher will provide some class time for this project.

On Tuesday **[5/2]**

you will have at least 30 minutes to choose and cut images and write a rough draft for the reasons that you chose them

On Thursday **[5/8]**

you will have at least 30 minutes to begin attaching them to teacher supplied 18 inch by 12-inch paper

Your Collage will be due to the teacher Wednesday, **[5/10]**

Your presentation will be due upon the return of your work

Presentations will begin on 5/10 and finish 5/12
