- 1) <u>A clear and detailed explanation or definition</u> of the exhibit's idea or concept
- 2) <u>A practical example or demonstration</u> that helps us clearly understand what is going on with the exhibit.
- Be sure that your response points out the significance that the exhibit is demonstrating.
- 4) Be careful that you do not create a simple 'cut and paste response; this will result in a loss of points
- 5) List the resources that you use for your information
