Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Forestville Historical Society for May, was opened at 3:05 p.m. by President Penny Hutten.

Present were Florence and Warren Templeton, Darleen Speer, Lorraine Owen, Penny Hutten, Virginia Hughes, Dave Henry, and Verna Blanc.

The secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were approved.

The treasurer reported \$451.24 in the Society's account.

Dues for the coming year will be payable in September of this year.

There will be no meeting in June because of the Youth Park Bar B Q and Carnival which will be held on our usual meeting day. Then we will be on hiatus until September so members may enjoy their vacations.

Members discussed the parade to be held Saturday, before the barbecue and carnival. It was decided we would all dress in vintage clothing for the parade, and we might possibly ride in some of the vintage cars instead of on the truck/float this year.

Shifts for maintaining the FHS booth at the Youth Park were set for Saturday and Sunday. We will all take 3 1/2 hour shifts to cover all day both days.

Virginia and Darleen will bring card tables, Penny will bring chairs and Darleen will bring pictures mounted on display boards to show at the booth. .

We voted to pay the \$25.00 required to have a sales permit so we can sell our calendars at the booth. We have decided on a price of \$15.00 for each calendar. There are still photo packets of old Forestville to sell as well, at \$10.00 per pack.

Virginia reported on sponsors for the calendar: Ridge Realty, Ideal Hardware, Forestville Pharmacy, Scissorhands, Bryce Bowen Engineers, the chiropractor, Forestville Realty, Speers Market, the bakery and possibly Topolos have all promised backing. Almost \$1,000.00 has been pledged.

Penny reported on pricing for printing the calendars. Depending on whether we buy the paper separately or not and other details, quotes ranged from \$200.00 at Kinko's to \$819.00 at Sir Speedy. We currently have \$650.00 on hand to work with and will limit to that amount unless things change.

We edited the captions for the calendar. Monday, Darleen and Verna will meet at Penny's at 7:00 p.m. to report corrections that were made and that will complete composing the calendar. Printing will be done within two weeks or so.

In new business, our Society wrote to the California Historical Society to recommend that Jeff Tobes be recognized for his contribution to the furthering of Forestville history.

The next meeting will be in September, 2002.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
