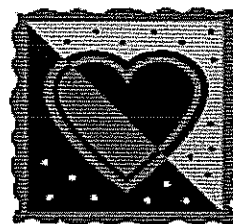
St. Rose Girl Scout Troops' Cookie Booth!

VOICE MAIL TO REPORT ABSENCE: Please use our school’s Voice Mail Number (284-1551) to report your child’s absence **BY 9:00 A.M.** It is only necessary to report on the first day of the absence. When a student returns to school, a written excuse to the teacher is required which includes the date of the absence, reason for the absence, and parent signature. **If you also want to pick up homework, please make sure you request it each day.**



EARLY DISMISSALS & DURING SCHOOL APPOINTMENTS: Please, whenever possible, send a note to your child’s teacher advising them in advance of appointments and other occasions when your child must leave school early. This allows the teacher to prepare the child for the interruption in the schedule.



REQUESTS FOR HOMEWORK: Please use the school’s Voice Mail Number (284-1551). Teachers will do their best to have assignments ready for pickup in the office or the classroom by 3:00 p.m. Please request homework no later than 9:00 a.m. Due to their busy instructional day, teachers may not have time to prepare assignments if requested later. **REPORTING A STUDENT’S ABSENCE DOES NOT GENERATE A HOMEWORK REQUEST. IF YOU WANT TO PICK UP HOMEWORK MAKE SURE YOU REQUEST IT EACH DAY.**
