- Curbside Service
 - Monday through Saturday, 10 AM to 3 PM
- Online Resources Available 24/7
 - Ebooks, E-audiobooks, Streaming Movies & TV Shows
 - Magazines digital versions
 - Databases
 - Virtual events
- Materials Return
 - Fridays and Saturdays the book drops open 10 AM to 5 PM.
 - Drops close early if the drops are filled up

Curbside Service

- Find materials & place them on hold using library catalog
 a) You need your library card number and 4-digit PIN
- 2. Get notified that materials are ready for pickup
 - b) By phone call, email or text
- 3. Come to the library to pick up your materials
 - c) No cell phone? Call from home to let us know you're on your way
