Dear Parents,

“Catholic Schools Raise the Standards” is this year’s theme for Catholic Schools Week which begins next Sunday with the 9:00 AM Mass and pancake breakfast at St. Rose Parish. We would greatly appreciate your family’s attendance. Whichever Mass or parish you attend, please have your children wear their dress uniforms so the Catholics in our diocese can see how many wonderful families sacrifice in order to give their children the gift of a Catholic education. I look forward to seeing you on Thursday night for our annual open house at the school. If you know families who are interested in having their children attend St. Rose, please bring them along to visit the classrooms and be sure to introduce them to me.

In response to the Sandy Hook tragedy, we have been reviewing our safety procedures. We are enhancing our security through the following measures:

- Safety locks have recently been installed on all classroom doors so that teachers can lock the hallway doors from the inside. It is now standard procedure for teachers to keep all outside doors locked.
- We are adding additional surveillance cameras along with a dedicated monitor in the office so that all approaches to the school are visible at all times during the school day. We greatly appreciate the Dad’s Club for the funding to make this possible.
- Soon new visitor name tags will be available with the visitor’s name and date. All volunteers and visitors will be required to sign in and wear these yellow badges while on campus, even those of you who are here frequently. This will make it easy to question anyone who does not seem to belong here.
- We have revised our lockdown drill procedures according to the newest information available on best practices. A Sonoma County deputy will be observing a drill soon to offer advice and allow us to build the relationship with our first responders.

Keeping your child safe both physically and emotionally is very important to us. Please call or email me if you have any questions, comments, ideas or concerns.

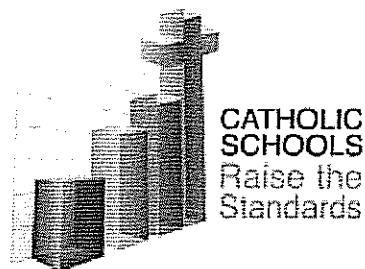
Baptismal Preparation Class

Tuition Assistance Application Information for the 2013-2014 School Year

St. Rose School uses a service called FAIR (Financial Aid Independent Review) to independently evaluate the financial needs of our families. FAIR requires an application and supporting documentation with options of applying by mail or online. There is a \$27.00 processing fee which is due at the time of submission. An additional \$10.00 fee is charged to process a business tax return. Applications must be received by FAIR by **March 1, 2013. It is important to plan ahead for this early deadline. FAIR requires a copy of your 2012 tax return, supporting schedules & W-2's.** Application packets will be mailed the 1st week of January, 2013. **Online applications with FAIR are available beginning February 1, 2013.**

All applications will be evaluated and families will be notified of scholarship awards as soon as possible after the school receives notification that the application is complete. Our Tuition Assistance Committee, which is made up of the Principal, the Business Manager and Superintendent of Schools, will review all applications. All requests and financial information are confidential.
