Biography

For the past fifteen years **Greer Upton** has been the director of the EXCEL Youth Enrichment Program at Sonoma State University (http://www.sonoma.edu/exed/excel/).

Greer Upton is an adjunct faculty member at Santa Rosa Junior College Art Department. She has created installations pieces and performance art locally at SRJC Art Gallery, SSU Art Gallery, Cinnabar Theater, Polly Klass Theater and at Fiberworks in Berkeley.

She was a founding teacher at Sonoma Country Day School where she worked with students as the artist in residence for ten years. She created and directed after school and summer art programs for Sonoma Country Day School.

Ms Upton co-founded and was the co-director of Evolution Art Institute, an art and ecology center that served Sonoma county in the 70's. She was an art instructor for CETA and YETP. She created pilot art programs and taught visual art media for 25 years in public and private schools in Sonoma and Marin counties often as a recipient of California Arts Council, Artist in Residence Grants.

She served on the boards of the Sebastopol Center for the Arts and the Sonoma County Arts Council where she was the crafts judge for Artrium. She was a founding member of Artists-in-the-Schools, 1981.

Ms Upton created the Graton Cleanup and the community group Graton Today. She was a past member of the Business Education Roundtable Advisory Board. She was a workshop leader for Leadership Santa Rosa and for Tomorrow's Leaders Today.

She studied performance/masks with Alan Kaprow, Susan Nininger and Judy Slattum. Her masks have been exhibited nationally. She assisted Bay Area performance artist Tony Pelligrino, Fred Curchack and Tom Chown with set design and masks. She studied spiritual traditions with Angeles Arrien and Erica Knowles which have influenced her work as an artist.

She was a presenter in Washington, D. C., and researcher for The Youth Caucus of the National University Continuing Education Association.
