Pradzynski's architectural forms, while remaining classic in design, create mysterious shadows as well as secret passageways. Whether it is an empty street, the riderless bicycle propped against a wall, an unattended table in a small cafe, his images reveal the impulse in us all to hold tight to traces of the past, while the occasional open doorway lends the imagery mystery and suggests a future, inevitable yet unknown."
