

Smart Phones, WOW!

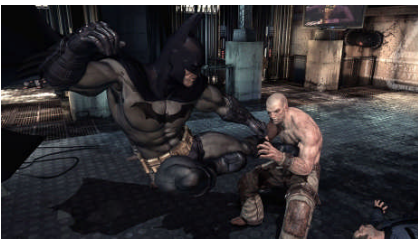

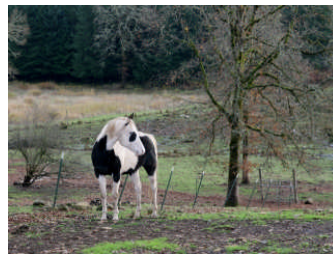
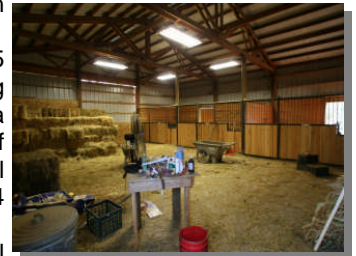
\$495k Horse Property

I took this listing earlier this week. This is a fabulous home in Battle Ground, Washington on Lucia Falls Road. I haven't had a listing like this in quite a while and I am excited to present this fine property to the public.

The house was built in 2006 and features 3 bedrooms, a den and 2 baths all on one level. The home has 9 foot ceilings and soaring vaults in the living room.

The property is 7.55 acres of gentle sloping ground running from Lucia Falls road at an elevation of 470 feet above sea level down to the bottom at 404 feet.

There are two additional buildings on the site, a 784 square foot animal barn with and a fabulous 2140 square foot building that was erected in 2007. The latter is divided into two areas. The first is a 24x36 foot shop with two 12 foot high roll up doors and the second area is a 36x36 foot barn with 3 horse stalls each with dutch doors leading outside.
