1. **START and FINISH at Petaluma Marina**  
Public bathrooms, launching ramp, and docks. Home to Friends of the Petaluma River, Petaluma Sea Scouts, Lokahi and Ohana Wa'a Outrigger Canoe Clubs.

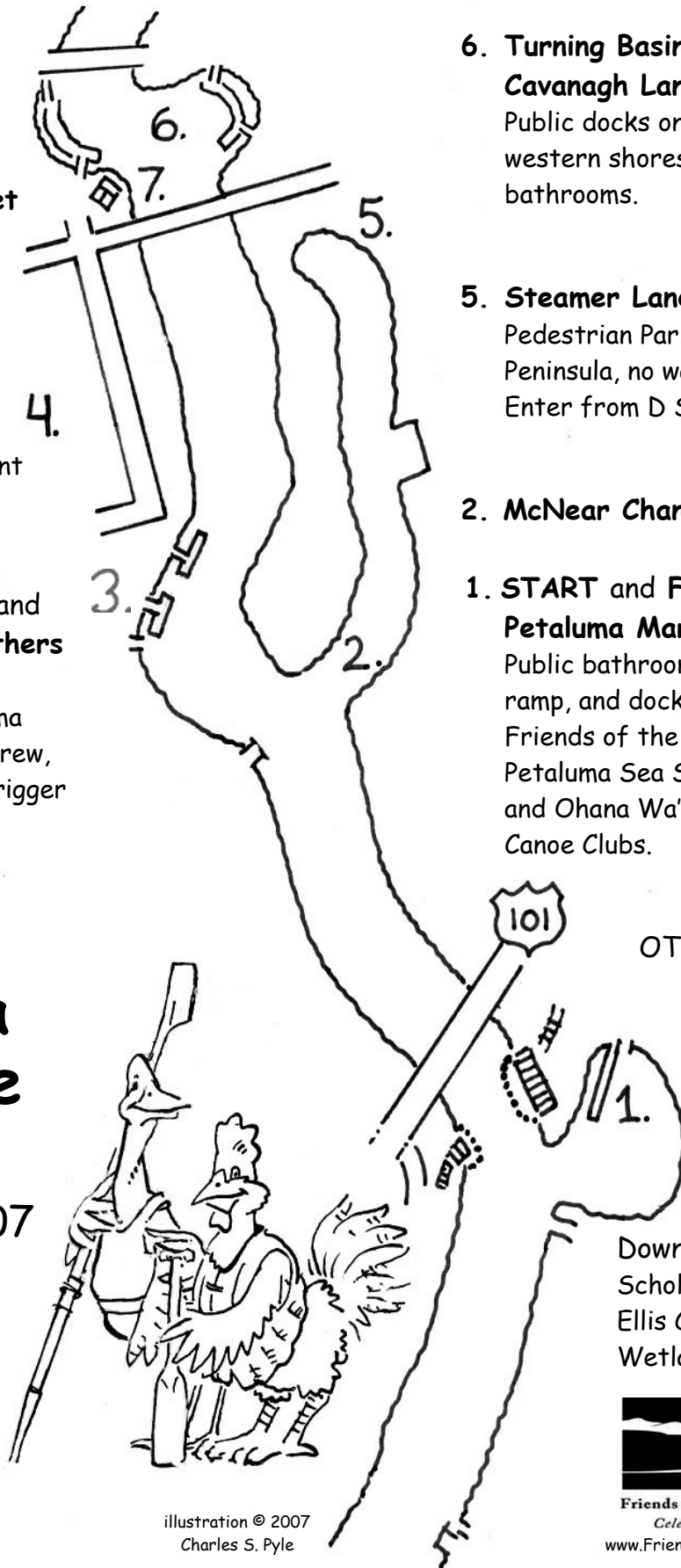
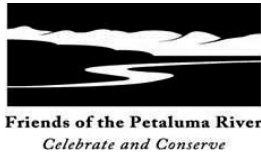

## MAYORS' BOAT RIDE INFORMATION



Welcome to the Mayor's Boat Ride! We appreciate your participation and ask for your cooperation in making this a safe and successful event.

### Safety Rules:

1. Participants are responsible for their own safety at all times.
2. Only non-motorized watercraft are allowed to participate.
3. Approved Personal Flotation Devices must be worn by everyone. Please put on your PFDs before launching.
4. Event Coordinators (wearing armbands) are available to answer questions and give assistance throughout the day. Please cooperate and thank these kind individuals.

**This is a Ride, not a Race!**

**LAUNCHING INSTRUCTIONS:** For smooth and considerate use of ramp facilities.

**Car-Top Watercraft** - Please park first (in a non-trailer space if possible) and carry your craft to the launch ramp along with paddles and safety gear. Raise your hand or a paddle if you need assistance.

If there are other boats in your party, wait for them ashore before launching.

Launch and board your craft from the ramp or back side of dock and proceed to the staging area below the pivot bridge.

**Trailer Watercraft** - Stop near, but clear, of the boat ramp and prepare your craft for launching.

When ready, back down the ramp and allow an assistant to tie up your boat while you park the car and trailer.

Board your boat and proceed to the staging area below the pivot bridge.

**All Boat Operators** - Keep the launch ramps as clear as possible.

Keep clear of large paddle craft & motorized vessels as they can't maneuver easily

**Upon arriving at the Turning Basin, stay in your craft and float near the Yacht Club dock for presentations and press photos.**

**We want you together to see and be seen!**

After presentations the mayor will continue the parade back to the Marina, but we invite participants to tie up, visit the displays, enjoy refreshments and/or stay in town for lunch.
