WATERSPORTS SUMMER CAMPS OFFERED ON PETALUMA RIVER

Petaluma -- This summer, the Petaluma Small Craft Center Coalition (PSC3) will coordinate three one-week watersports camps on the Petaluma River. The three sessions will take place the weeks of June 16th, July 7th, and August 4th from 9:00AM until 3:00PM each day. Each session is open to twelve students, ages twelve and older. Rowing instruction will take place in the mornings until lunch, followed by afternoon instruction in the paddling of outrigger canoes and kayaks. In addition, there will be a session on river heritage combined with a scenic river cruise.

The cost of each one-week session is \$125 per student. Students should be in good physical condition and be able to swim. Campers must provide their own lunches, although snacks and drinks will be provided. For further information, please call Greg Sabourin, at (707) 293-3685.

PSC3 is a coalition of river users, advocates, and educators, and whose mission is to promote small craft access to the Petaluma River: primarily through the development of a community small craft center for boat storage, instruction, rental, and education. Organizations participating in the summer camps include the NorthBay Rowing Club, the Lokahi and He'e Nalu Outrigger Canoe Clubs, Clavey Kayaks, the Petaluma Paddlers, the Friends of the Petaluma River, and the Petaluma Sea Scouts.
